We look forward to having your child join us in what promises to be an exciting summer. Camp Kaitana shares the same philosophy as our preschool. Children learn best by “doing.” At Camp Kaitana, each child is encouraged to explore the environment, make discoveries, ask questions and gain competence by engaging in “hands-on” activities. We create a warm and supportive environment that helps children develop self-confidence, independence, and the ability to cooperate and solve problems, all in a Jewish setting. Most importantly, camp is **FUN!**

Camp is in session from 9:15 am—1:15 pm. An extended day option is available two days per week (Tuesday and Thursday) for campers enrolled in our three year old and four year old programs. Campers should bring a dairy or non-meat (pareve) lunch to enjoy. Snack will be provided.

ENROLLMENT

Camp enrollment is open to children ages 2 to 5. In order to attend the two year old program at Camp Kaitana, the child **MUST** turn 2 prior to June 30, 2010 and **MUST BE** enrolled in BEECC for the 2010-2011 school year.

TUITION

Tuition is due in full no later than **Friday, June 11, 2010** for ALL sessions. A 10% discount is available for the tuition of second and subsequent children. Tuition is non-refundable.

REGISTRATION

All camp applications are due by Friday, April 2, 2010. Any application received after April 2, will be processed as received on a space available basis. You may mail your camp application to or bring it to the school office.

Priority Registration will begin on **Monday, February 1, 2010.**

Priority Registration is open to eligible children of Congregation Beth Emeth members in good standing and children currently enrolled in BEECC and their siblings.

Open Registration will begin on **Monday, March 1, 2010.** Open registration is open to the general public.

Spaces are limited. Each camp session is subject to a minimum and maximum enrollment.
