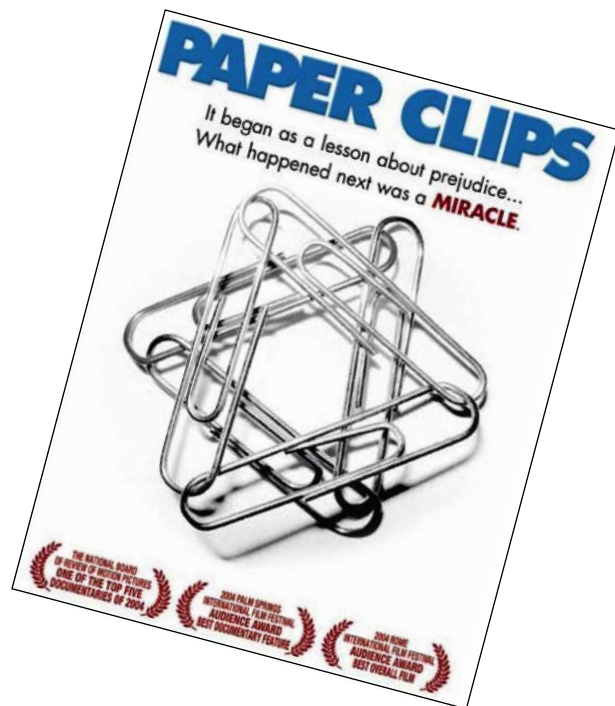


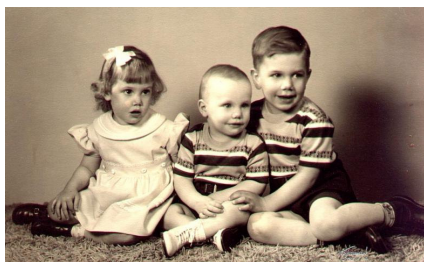
Congregation Beth Emeth Yom HaShoah Observance

4:30 PM - 6:30 PM**



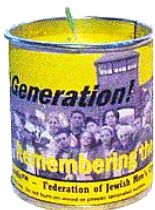
